The Lead (TV series) *The Lead* is a Canadian reality television series that airs on the American television channel MTV. It is the first US edition of the Canadian series *The Lead*. It is hosted by Canadian singer Avril Lavigne and is produced by the Canadian company The Foundation. The first series, hosted by Shaunta Lewis and John Viacava, aired on MTV in 2008. A second series, with new host Sophia Coscarelli, aired in 2009. Both series were axed after one season.

Production history In the autumn of 2007, the Canadian television channel CTV announced the winner of *The Lead*. On 7 January 2008, MTV announced that it had acquired the rights to the series. On 5 October 2008, MTV announced that it had decided to end *The Lead*. The show was filmed in Montreal and Toronto. It was hosted by Canadian MTV VJ Shaunta Lewis and American MTV VJ John Viacava. The show featured eight young male contestants, one female contestant, and one celebrity. In its first season, the show was filmed in Toronto and Montreal. The show was taped in Las Vegas during its second season. The first season of *The Lead* aired in Canada in 2008. A second season aired in 2009 with a new set of rules, based on the same concept, but where the male contestants were from different parts of Canada. In this season, the male contestants were divided into three teams of four, with each team representing one part of the country. In 2010, MTV cancelled the show, as they found that the show wasn't reaching any of the target audience. Although ratings weren't spectacular, the show had a consistent number of viewers during the time it aired.

Rules The male contestants competed to be the lead singer in an all-male band. Each team consisted of a front man, two backup singers, a keyboardist, and a drummer. They competed against each other for a \$25,000 prize and a recording contract with Universal Records. The contestants were each given a group of male singers to cover. One singer was the lead singer of the group. The other singers were the backup singers. After each contestant performed a 2d92ce491b
